How to determine your ring size

## Use your existing ring to find your size.

1. Print page to actual size.
2. Double check by measuring the actual size reference with a ruler, it should be 1 inch.
3. Place existing ring over each circle until there is a match. There should be a very thin black border inside the ring.
4. If the ring is covering the black outline completely, choose the next largest size.

## Use included ruler to find your size.

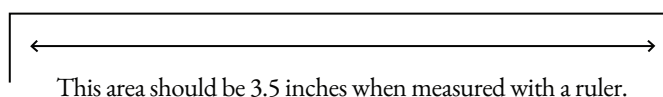
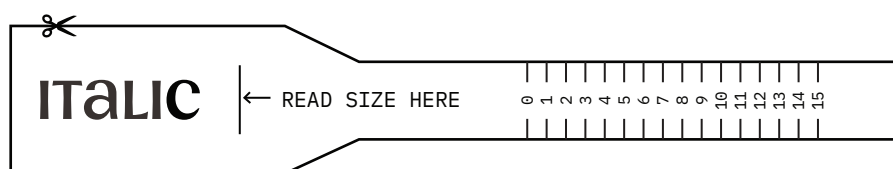
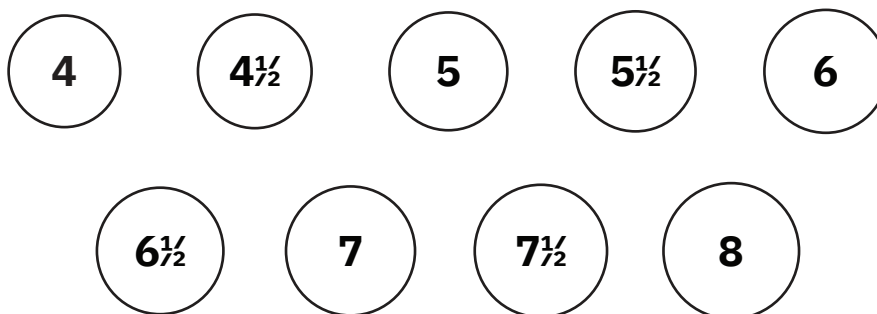
1. Print page to actual size.
2. Double check by measuring the reference area under the ruler, it should be 3.5 inches.
3. Cut out the ring ruler and wrap around your finger to measure. The numbers on the ruler indicate ring sizes.
